

# STUDENT BURSARIES

As in previous years, the Construction History Society will once again be offering a limited number of student bursaries.

## ELIGIBILITY

1) You must be a registered student to qualify, in a recognised University. You must attach a letter by email with your application proving your student status. You may be an undergraduate or graduate student. Recent graduates or those who have completed their course or recently submitted will be considered but only after all the other candidates. Independent scholars who are not students are not eligible.

2) You must be presenting a paper and have had it accepted for the proceedings. You may apply if your abstract has been accepted and you submitted a paper, even if you do not yet know whether it has been fully accepted.

## HOW TO APPLY

Applications must be received by 31 January 2020.

## WHAT DO I GET?

The bursary will pay for registration, accommodation (max.3 nights) and the gala dinner for one person. You must pay for your own transport to Cambridge and any additional costs (meal on Friday night).

## I HAVE ALREADY REGISTERED, IS THAT A PROBLEM?

If you have already paid and your application is successful then you will be refunded any money already paid in February. You should thus go ahead and register whether or not you are applying for a bursary.
